1. Accounts

Treasurer update

Future expenditure

Machine Control course – agreed that if drinks (water) were purchased by the tutor(s) delivering the course for the attendees then this can be re-imbursed providing valid receipt along with a general expenditure form.

DP mentioned that for him to teach new tutors he has to use his own vehicle and fuel approx. (£70-£100) MK – suggested that this to be re-imbursed through the club funds. Agreed by committee that 45p per mile (as stated on the HMRC website) to be paid to DP when training a new associate.

CH to create a general expense form to be circulated (AP)

Covering the cost of free membership for the raffle

Dave Richards to confirm with the Gambling Commission, if we are legally able to hold raffles within the club (AP)

No free membership to be offered as a prize at the raffle If raffle can go ahead, prizes up to the value of £50 to be bought by CC, and reimbursed by the club, along with receipts and a general expenditure form.

3. Training Issues
