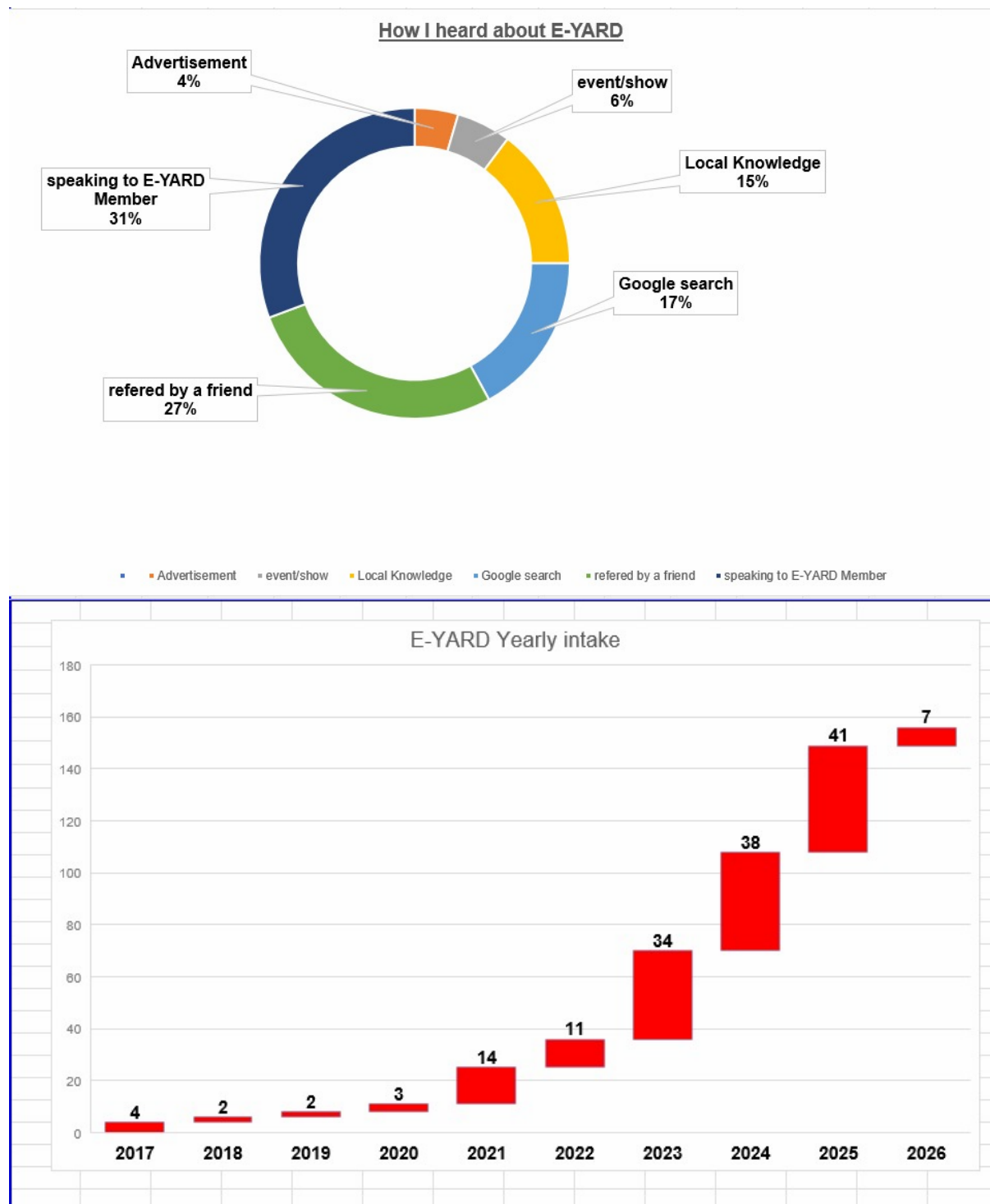

4.Chair Report.

A review of the current financial status revealed the club to be in a healthy position to continue delivering its core purpose - Advanced Bike and Car training to a very high standard, with a well trained and equipped tutor cadre.

Membership was also revealed to be excellent, seeing year on year recruitment and retention to be growing exponentially. Indeed the group has already had 7 new memberships in the past month or so.

Paul Garrod - membership secretary - presented graphs and charts to illustrate this growth and what was particularly interesting was the methods of recruitment with engagement and recommendation dominating this.

A review of the past year by the Chair underscored the growth and professionalism of the club, especially regarding the process of tutor training. Seven recently qualified tutors were presented with their certificates of successful qualification, they were Keith Peason (Car), Pete Peter Wright (Car), Ian Wood (Car & Bike), John Milner (Bike), John Gabbetis (Bike), Mark Lawson (Bike), Al Mickleborough (Bike)

The members who had taken their advanced tests were celebrated, with 20 members either qualifying initially, tri-annual retesting or qualifying as advanced tutors. The number of passes exceeded 20, but not all details were available at the time of the AGM.
